Day 1: Istanbul

Upon arrival to Istanbul's airport, meet and transfer to the hotel Rest of the day at leisure to discover Istanbul

Day 2: Istanbul City Tour

Pick up at 08:30am from hotel to jointhe tour of old Istanbul city Visit St. Sophia, Topkapi Palace, the Blue Mosque and the Hippodrome After lunch, the tour ends at the Grand Covered Bazaar

Day 3: Istanbul - Izmir -Kusadasi

In the morning, depart for a Bosphorus Cruise tour Lunch break at a Turkish restaurant, then depart for Istanbul'sairport for domestic flight to Izmir

Day 4:Kusadasi - Ephesus - Sirince

Early in the morning, depart from the hotel and follow a fully guided tour of Ephesus Visiting the Temple of Artemis, Curetes street, famous Roman baths Celsus Library, Grand theatre and House of the Virgin Mary After Lunch, enjoy a Turkish Village Tour and discover the Sirince's construction style Sirince Village also has a fantastic reputation for making some of the best wines in Turkey Learn how to make fruit wine with Turkish wine makers On the way back, visit one of the famous leather production centers of the region

Day 5: Kusadasi - Pamukkale Tour

In the morning, depart for Pamukkale.

Visit the calcium terracesof Pamukkale (cotton castle) and the ruins of Hierapolis, then walk around this natural phenomenon and have the option of lying in the waters of the natural springs

Day 6: Pamukkale - Denizli-Nevsehir- Cappadocia

Depart for Denizli Airport for a domestic flight to Cappadocia Transfer to the Cave hotel Rest of the day to explore Cappadocia

Day 7: Cappadocia

Today, get to know the Cappadocia region,

a volcanic area in which the geological formation started 10 million years ago.

The tour starts with Uchisar Castle, the highest point of Cappadocia

After Uchisar, you will visit Goreme Open Air Museum, the Heart of Cappadocia.

GoremeOpen Air Museum is famous for frescoes dating to 10th century describing the life of Jesus Christ and monks Next stop is Cavusin, which is an abandoned village with old cave Greek houses

After Cavusin go to the restaurant in Avanos to have lunch

Afterwards, visit a pottery work shop and go to Pasabagi where it is possible to see the three-headed fairy chimneys Next stop is Devrent Valley, which is also called Imagination Valley, where you can see natural rock formations looking like animals

Then you head to a wine shop in Urgup for wine tasting

Last stop is Three Beauties, three beautiful fairy chimneys with their hats, which is the symbol of Cappadocia

Day 8: Cappadocia - Istanbul

Time at leisure in the morning to enjoy shopping in Cappadocia Then depart for Kayseri airport for your domestic flight to Istanbul and then back home
