

Day 1 (Sunday): Rome

Upon arrival to Rome's international airport, meet greet and transfer to hotel

Day 2 (Monday): Rome - Assisi - Siena - Florence

Early in the morning, departure to Assisi and visit of the mystic town of Saint Francis Visit the Basilica of Saint Francis with its early Renaissance masterpieces by Giotto and Cimabue

At the end of the visit, continue towards Siena, the beautiful medieval city renown for the Palio horse race

Proceed to Florence

Day 3 (Tuesday): Florence

Today, you will enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of the city, also known to be the cradle of the Renaissance Visit the beautiful Piazza del Duomo, the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistery of St. John, and Santa Croce, the 13th century Franciscan Church with Cimabue's famous crucifix The balance of the day is at leisure for optional sightseeing

#### Day 4 (Wednesday): Florence - Padua - Venice

Early in the morning, departure to Venice. Along the way you will stop in Padua, where you will visit the famous Cathedral of St. Anthony, guarded by Donatello's "Gattamelata"

Continue towards Venice, and upon arrival enjoy a panoramic guided walking tour of this unique city You will see the St. Mark's square, the Basilica of St. Mark, the Doge's Palace, the Bridge of Sighs and the Prisons

#### Day 5 (Thursday): Venice-Rome

Today you will enjoy a morning tour by boat. You will cross the lagoon with a view of the islands and reach the island of Murano where you will assist to a demonstration of glass

In the afternoon, the boat will take you to the rail station or the Tronchetto for your transfer back to Rome Arrival in Rome and transfer to the hotel

## Day 6 (Friday): Rome - Naples - Pompeii - Sorrento

Lemons and Olives trees

Early in the morning departure from Rome to with a multilingual tour leader
Upon arrival in Naples our local guide will take you for a walking tour of the historical center to admire the Piazza del Plebiscito, the Royal Palace, the Gallery of Umberto I, and the San Carlo Opera House
From Naples, continue to Pompeii, and enjoy a short visit to a coral and cameo factory
Lunch in a typical restaurant, followed by a visit of the excavations of this ancient Roman city which was destroyed by the eruption of Mount Vesuvio in 79 b.C. and buried under 4 to 6 meters of ash and stones
Proceed to Sorrento, a charming town of the Sorrentine Peninsula famous for the cultivation of Oranges,

## Day 7 (Saturday): Sorrento - Capri - Sorrento

Departure at 8.00 am to the island of Capri. Board a ferry and arrive in Marina Grande
Once on the island you will visit the Blue Grotto, the Augustus Gardens and stop at the famous Piazzetta
A Minibus will take you up to Anacapri. After lunch in Anacapri, you will return to Marina Grande where you will board the ferry for your transfer back to Sorrento

## Day 8 (Sunday): Sorrento - Amalfi

Today, you will depart to Amalfi at 9.30am via the breathtaking Amalfi Coast drive
En-route you will enjoy magnificent views of Positano and other picturesque fishing villages
Arrival in Amalfi and time at leisure. You can take the hotel's shuttle bus to reach its private beach and plunge
into the water of the Mediterranean Sea. Alternatively, you may visit the city center of Amalfi







Day 9 (Monday): Amalfi

Day at leisure to discover the beauty of this wonderful coastal village, or to explore the area

Day 10 (Tuesday): Amalfi - Pompeii - Rome

Morning at leisure

Meeting point at the hotel at 3.30pm and transfer to Pompeii and then back to Rome

Day 11 (Wednesday):Rome

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight
