Day 1: Lusaka

Upon arrival at Lusaka's airport, meet greet and transfer to the airport

Days 2-4: South Luangwa Valley

Take the short flight from Lusaka to Mfuwe, at the edge of South Luangwa National Park, where your hosts will meet you and drive you to Sanctuary Puku Ridge Camp. The camp is set on an escarpment providing spectacular views across a floodplain on which you might spot zebra or endemic Thornicroft's giraffe grazing and browsing. 'The Valley', as South Luangwa is known to old Africa hands, offers some of Zambia's —indeed, Africa's —finest game viewing and bird spot-ting, hosting dense wildlife including most of the charismatic large mammals. But Luangwa is most renowned for two factors: it's home to some of Africa's best-trained, most knowledgeable and enthusiastic guides; and it's the birthplace of the walking safari. Roaming on foot across savannah and riverine woodland, meeting lion or elephant, is an electrifying experience. You'll want to join at least one night drive, with leopard sightings a regular treat.

Day 5: South Luangwa Valley / Livingstone

Look out for game on the drive back to Mfuwe for your flight to Livingstone Airport, where you'll be met and driven to Sanctuary Sussi & Chuma Lodge, close to Victoria Falls. Known locally as Mosi oa Tunya, 'the smoke that thunders', at peak flow this chain of roaring cataracts creates the world's largest curtain of water, with 10 million litres gushing over its lip every second. The lodge overlooks a dramatic bend in the Zambezi upstream from the falls, providing an exclusive haven in the heart of Mosi oa Tunya National Park—take a walking safari or game drive to spot white rhino, elephant, buffalo, zebra and possibly even African wild dog, along with dazzling birdlife.

Days 6-7: Livingstone

The character of the falls changes with the season, the viewpoint and even the time of day. With two days to explore the area, you can view the cascades from Knife-Edge Bridge, from the air on a 'Flight of Angels' helicopter tour, from Livingstone Island from where David Livingstone got his first glimpse of the falls, or even taking a dip in the Devil's Pool on the very edge of the cataract. The vast Zambezi itself offers a range of activities: paddle a kayak, cast a fishing line or end the day with a sundowner on a sunset cruise. You can also discover more about Zambian rural life with a visit to Nakatindi Village, an inspiring community school and village project supported by the lodge.

Day 8: Livingstone
