Day 1: NAIROBI / AMBOSELI

Upon arrival at Nairobi Airport you are met by our representative and drive south east of Nairobi to Amboseli National Park.

Arrive on time for lunch. Later in the afternoon you get a chance to visit a Maasai tribal village and enjoy entertainment by Masai dancers.

Overnight and dinner in your 5* Lodge

Day 2: AMBOSELI

Spend a further day in the park on morning and afternoon game viewing drives. Wildlife here includes the zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, impala, caracal and serval cat, lion, leopard, cheetah, buffalo among others. There are also over 400 species of birds, including the bee-eater, kingfisher, African fish eagle, martial eagle and pygmy falcon. Visitors mainly come to watch the huge herds of elephants. You can also enjoy excellent views of Mt Kilimanjaro and Meru.

All meals and overnight in your 5* Lodge.

Day 3: AMBOSELI/ NAKURU

After breakfast, depart to Lake Nakuru which is one of the Rift Valley soda lakes at an elevation of 1754 m above sea level. Later in the afternoon depart for the game drive in the park. Lake Nakuru is among Kenya's finest national parks.

Later in the evening return for Dinner and overnight at your 5* Lodge (Full Board)

Day 4: NAKURU /MASAI MARA

After breakfast depart for a Journey on to Masai Mara Game Reserve, so named to mean the "spotted plains" in Maa language. This is home to the greatest concentration of large mammals and is widely recognized as Africa's ultimate wildlife reserve.

Arrive at the camp on time for lunch. Later in the afternoon you get a chance to visit a Maasai tribal village and enjoy entertainment by Masai dancers.

All meals and overnight at your 5* Camp (full board).

Day 5: MASAI MARA

After breakfast, spend the day on full day on game drives and during your stay, you have the opportunity to explore this great reserve in depth. While in Mara, you will have the option to float above the Mara-Serengeti ecosystem on board a hot air balloon followed by a gourmet champagne breakfast (Optional tours).

Meals and overnight your 5* Camp (full board).

Day 6: MASAI MARA / NAIROBI / DEPART

After breakfast morning drive back to Nairobi. Arrive in time for lunch and later transferred to the Airport for your outbound flight..
